Data used in this ranking are provided by the Organ Procurement and Transplant Network (www.unos.org), and include deceased and living donor kidney and kidney/pancreas transplants. The OPTN recorded 9,401 deceased kidney donors in 2017 (9,116 in 2016) and 5,817 living kidney donors (5,626 in 2016), resulting in 5,811 living kidney donor transplants (5,629 in 2016) and 14,038 deceased donor kidney transplants (13,431 in 2016). There were also 789 kidney/pancreas transplants in 2017 (798 in 2016).
